We will try to honor your top choices but assignments are based on a first-come, first-served basis. Some activities are limited to a specific number of participants. To avoid disappointment, register early. With the exception of Seal Watch, a minimum of 5 participants must be signed up for a field trip to be held.

HALF-DAY (Pick 4 in order of preference)

- 1. FISHY-FISHY:** Science, Marine Life & Beachcombing (beach pottery) (max 20)
- 2. LOW TIDE CROSSING:** Historic Buildings, Island Exploration & Beachcombing (sea glass & driftwood) (max 20)
- 3. AHOY MATEY!** (small boat) Boating over & exploring an isolated island's shoreline (sea glass, pottery, clay pipe stems) (max 15)
- 4. TOWNIE TOUR:** Museums, Peninsula Park Beachcomb (sea glass, pottery, clay pipe stems) (max 25)
- 5. SEAL WATCH:** Boat Tour of Passamaquoddy Bay marine life & jetty beachcomb (driftwood, sea glass, pottery, clay pipe stems) (min. 30 – max 40)

- 6. A FUNDY ISLAND:** (ferry) Explore island/villages; beachcomb (max. 15)
- 7. A WEST PARISH ISLAND:** (ferry) View a local beachcomber's collection; explore island; beachcomb (max. 20)
- 8. CITY SLICKERS:** Explore New Brunswick's largest city, Museum and Nature Park beachcomb (max. 25)
- 9. WILLY WONKA goes COMBING!** Museum, Nature Park/Beachcomb (max. 25)
